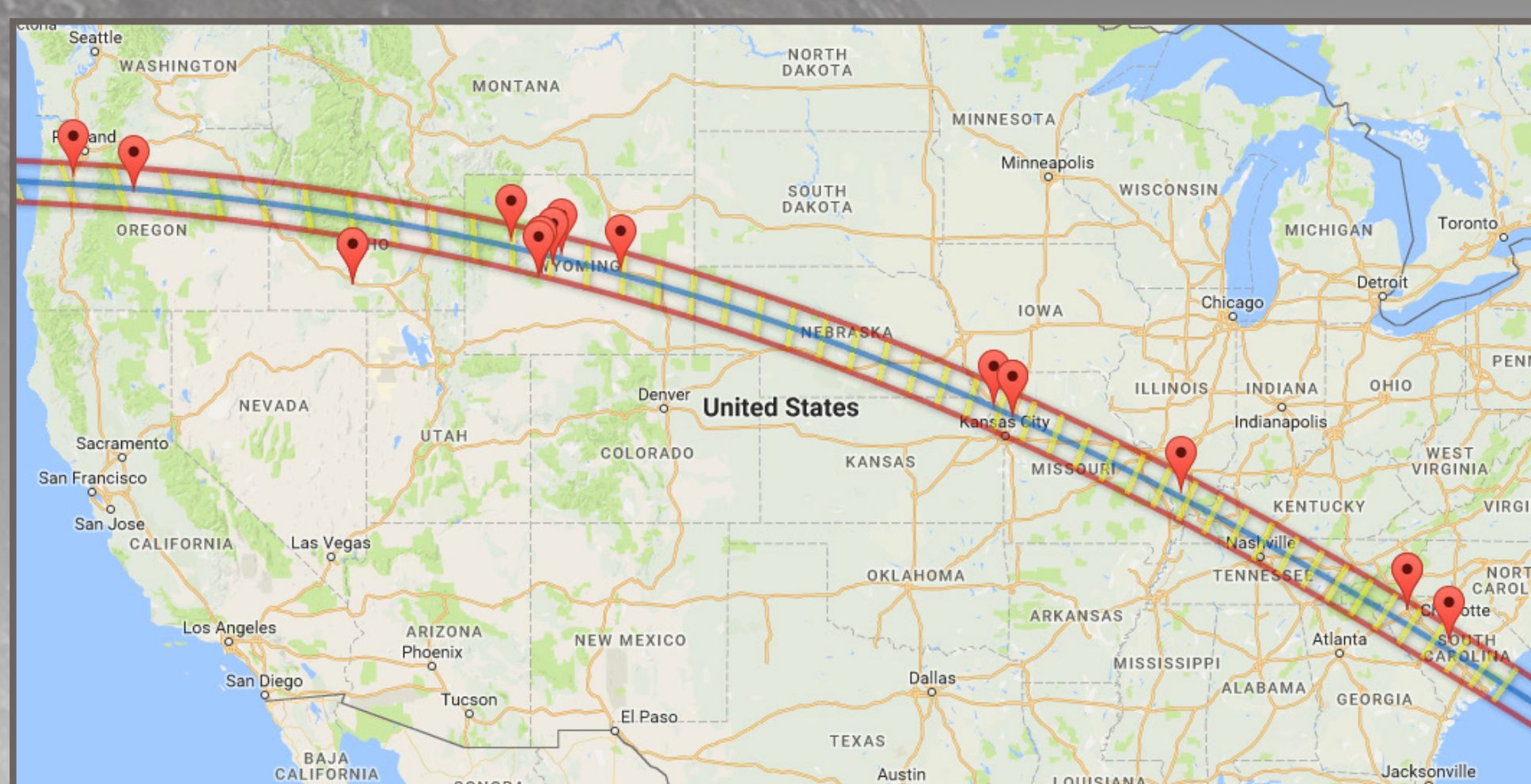




GET MOONED!

TSGC COMPETITION FOR IN-SERVICE TEACHERS



The 2017 Solar Eclipse provides a spectacular opportunity to help our students more fully understand the relationships between the Earth, Moon and Sun, their 'behaviors' and their characteristics. In other words, "Get Mooned" will make perfect sense!

Prior to the final selection, teachers will have created lessons on the Earth, Moon, Sun and the Eclipse. Semi-finalists will be interviewed via Skype about their lessons, their scope, and the range of their impact. Ten teachers, selected by the NASA Texas Space Grant Consortium, will be flown from Dallas to Nashville to view the Eclipse.

- Submit a unit (3 lessons minimum) about the Sun, Earth, Moon, and Eclipses by February 28, 2017
- Lessons matched to grade level and educational standards.
- Include details on how you will prepare students and the community to safely and successfully view the eclipse.
- Must have principal's permission to attend this professional development opportunity August 20-22, 2017.
