These scholarships are intended to recognize teachers enrolled in a Masters program in STEM fields at a TSGC member institution.

\$1500 STIPEND

The scholarships stress:

- Excellence in academics
- Participation in science, technology, engineering and/or mathematics education projects
- Current Teacher in STEM field grade level 5 and up
- Exhibited leadership qualities

Under-represented minority students, female students, and students with disabilities are encouraged to apply.

ELIGIBILITY

All TSGC Scholarship recipients must be:

1. Citizens of the United States
2. Enrolled in Masters Program at a TSGC member institution in good standing
3. Hold a Bachelor's Degree
4. Attend a TSGC institution (*visit our website for the list*)
